YMCA Before & After School Program in Licking Heights School District

Program Locations:

Broad Peak Elementary-in cafeteria at Broad Peak Elementary, use main entrance for AM and PM care drop off/pick up.

Everest Elementary-children are bussed by the school district to Broad Peak, use main entrance for AM and PM care drop off/pick up.

Lima Ridge Elementary-children are bussed by the school district to and from Broad Peak Elementary. Use the main entrance of Broad Peak for AM and PM care drop off/pick up.

Summit Station (Central) (5th and 6th graders)-PM only program and the children are walked by YMCA staff to Broad Peak for PM care. Please use main entrance for pick up.
